COLLEAGUES CELEBRATE BILL NELSON'S FOUR DECADES OF SERVICE *Local firm makes \$10,000 gift to keep UA engineering course alive*

Tucson, AZ (February 26, 2010) — Marking 40 years of innovative professional practice and volunteer service to his community, colleagues from the University of Arizona and employee-owners of GLHN Architecture & Engineering, Inc. dedicated the new cooling towers at the University of Arizona's Central Heating and Refrigeration Plant to **Bill Nelson, P.E.** The celebration, took place on February 26 at the plant, which is part of an \$8 million upgrade completed by GLHN in 2009.

Nelson, a 1978 graduate of the University's College of Engineering and GLHN's president, has been part of over 200 campus design and construction projects and has guided and inspired several generations of architecture and engineering professionals, facilitating educational symposia for University staff and others and serving as an adjunct professor at both the graduate and undergraduate levels.



As an additional tribute, GLHN contributed \$10,000 to the UA College of Engineering in Nelson's name to ensure that the building systems engineering course he teaches as a volunteer for the Department of Aerospace and Mechanical Engineering can continue into the foreseeable future, despite continuing budget constraints at the University.
